The **Dawson Creek Choral Society** is a not-for-profit community organization that oversees music programming through the Kiwanis Performing Arts Centre. Our programs include weekly choir rehearsals, semi-annual public concerts, a youth musical theatre program, and participation in local arts and music ventures. DCCS is a member choir of the BC Choral Federation and Choral Canada. The Choral Society is funded by the **Encana Corporation** for professional development and community outreach activities through a choral workshop with High Street Sound, and this concert. The **SOCAN Foundation** is also a sponsor of this event, promoting Canadian concert music and event that foster musical engagement in our country. We hope that, through music, our community is inspired to continue to work toward diversity, positivity, and acceptance.



The **Dawson Creek Literacy Society** offers a wide range of services for our community. The Lake View Learning Centre is Dawson Creek's only Settlement Services and English Language provider. The Centre offers small group and one-on-one instruction in literacy for members of our community throughout the year, and our programs keep growing as the community's needs change. The Literacy Society is funded by the **Government of Canada** and the **Province of British Columbia** through the Organizing Against Racism and Hate (OARH) program.

OARH helps small communities collaboratively find ways to address incidents of racism and hate crime. There are 28 communities listed as OARH members in British Columbia and all have an established community partnership of organizations or individuals that actively develop community capacity and skills; foster community engagement; and build community sustainability plans to address racism and hate. There are also specific protocols on how to respond to an incident of racism in their community, and partners must provide an annual summary of incidents of racism observed/reported in their community. 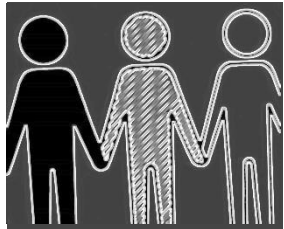
